Conflict of Interest Code

6020. General Provisions.

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and

local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political

Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730)

that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by

reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended

by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act.

Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it

duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference.

This regulation and the attached Appendix, designating positions and establishing disclosure

categories, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the Cannabis Control Appeals Panel

(Panel).

Panel members and the Executive Director must file their statements of economic

interests electronically with the Fair Political Practices Commission. All other individuals

holding designated positions must file their statements with the Panel. All statements must be

made available for public inspection and reproduction under Government Code Section 81008.

Designated Positions and Disclosure Categories

Position Title	Assigned Categories
Panel Member	1, 2
Executive Director	1, 2
Attorney (all levels)	1, 2
Associate Governmental Program Analyst	2

Category 1:

Individuals holding a designated position assigned to this category must report all interests in real property located in California as well as investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans and travel payments) if the business entity or source of income is any of the following:

- An applicant for, or current holder of, a cannabis license of any type; or
- The holder of a cannabis license of any type at any time within the preceding four years.

Category 2:

Individuals holding a designated position assigned to this category must report investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans and travel payments) if the business entity or source provides leased facilities, products, equipment, vehicles, machinery or services (including training or consulting services) of the type utilized by the Panel.
